BELLROPE KEYRINGS

Miniature Ship's Bellrope keyrings also useful for light pulls and blinds. Each one has these sailors' knots:

- Plait
- Matthew Walker
- Single Sinett
- Footrope Knot
- Double Sinett reversed
- Monkey's Fist

Made from light brown waxed cord. Approx, 4" long,
